#### Here are a few of the many options for exploring the area:

Contemplate ancestor Barzillai Delano's life as the lighthouse keeper at Fort Williams in 1796 Sun rise on the Atlantic Ocean, very early in the morning. (Longest days of the year, June, 19th 4:18 am -7:45 pm, 927 mins) Old Port downtown district: shopping, dining, historic buildings, cafes and cobblestone streets Read poetry and see the Henry Wadsworth Longfellow house on Congress street Guided tour of the historic landmark Portland Observatory the only remaining maritime signal tower and its 103 steps to the lantern deck Old Orchard Beach. Sandy beach, 7 miles long and the historic amusement park (Dourneaster train goes from Portland to OOB) Ferry boat rides on Casco Bay and its many islands. Sometimes called the Calendar islands for the myth that there are 365 of them (try 250). Visit an Island. Peaks Island is a 20 minute ferry ride at Casco Bay Lines in downtown Portland Rent a sea kayak, paddle the bay, picnic on an island or circumnavigate a historic fort Try candlepin bowling, if you dare. instructions - masscandlepin.com, big20bowling.com is a 6 min drive from hotel Clam chowder and lobster rolls. Also the Birthplace of the "Italian" sandwich - try Amatos Microbreweries, brewpubs & coffee shops (Including Geary's, Gritty's, Shipyard, Casco Bay & Alligash) Cemetery wandering: (Eastern est 1668 – has nice views of the bay, Also Western 1700's, Evergreen and Forest) L.L. Bean flagship store in Freeport, Maine (Downeaster train goes from Portland to Freeport) Walk the Eastern Prominade up on Munjoy Hill Crescent Beach State Park in Cape Elizabeth & Willard Beach in South Portland Ocean Tides: Portland has tidal ranges of 11 feet, two times daily Urban walking trails: Bug light and Spring Point light park, 900 foot granite breakwater, WWII memorial, museum Boats and fish: Active working waterfront on Commercial street in downtown Portland Art and Culture, Portland Museum of Art & Art galleries Narrow gauge railroad Farmers Market in Deering Oaks Park (Sat) Tour the McLellan-Sweet Mansion and/or the Victoria Mansion Visit 60 lighthouses in Maine!
